

CASHMERE WANDERERS – JUNIOR SECTION – CANCELLATIONS AND RELOCATION OF DEVELOPMENT (IN HOUSE) COMPETITION

Although football is a 'winter sport' and we can expect to play games in a variety of weather conditions, there are times when, either for player safety or because of ground conditions, we won't be able to play outside.

Development (in house) competition – 7th – 9th grades and starters (midgets)

Our development (or 'in house') competition (7-9th grades and starters programmes) is normally held at Centennial Park next to Pioneer Stadium on Saturday mornings from 9-12 am. However, from time to time, we will re-locate this competition to the Action Indoor Sports Centre in Iversen Terrace.

Relocation

The competition will be relocated for two main reasons;

- ground conditions (e.g., grounds are closed or unplayable)
- player safety (usually a poor weather forecast)

The decision whether to relocate will be made on Friday afternoon and if the decision to relocate is made, the following will apply;

- A notice will be posted on the Cashmere Wanderers website by 7.00 pm on Friday night advising that the competition has been relocated to Action Indoor Sports at Iversen Tce, Woolston
- The 'wet day' draw will apply (details on the website) including modified start times
- 'Indoor' rules will apply (details on the website)

Once the decision is made (either way) it will apply regardless of weather or ground conditions. If no notice is posted on our website, assume that the competition will be played at Centennial Park.

Cancellation

If the competition hasn't been relocated but weather conditions are bad on Saturday, we may cancel the competition altogether. The decision whether to cancel will be made on Saturday morning and will be notified by a notice on the Club website (by 8.00 am) and also via News Talk ZB (listen for Cashmere Wanderers Development Competition).

If games aren't cancelled, but weather conditions deteriorate during the morning, individual coaches can make the decision to cancel on a game by game basis. Contact details for all in house coaches are available in the coaches area on our website.

Mainland competitions (10th grade and above)

The decision to cancel Mainland competitions is made by Mainland Football.

Cancellations are posted on the Mainland website (www.mainlandfootball.co.nz which can be accessed via the link on our website www.cashmerefootball.co.nz). Cancellations are also broadcast on News Talk ZB, More FM and The Breeze.

Ground changes and closures

Last minute ground changes (caused by ground closures) for the Mainland competition are notified via the 'snapshot' on the Mainland website (late changes are marked in red).

Ground closures during the week are notified by the Christchurch City Council (www.ccc.govt.nz). Please note that if grounds are closed for training, we must not use them as the Club may be liable for repairing any damage caused by using grounds that have been closed.
